Ampicillin D-(-)α- Aminobenzylpenicillin sodium salt is a beta-lactam antibiotic with an amino group attached to the penicillin structure. Ampicillin is effective against Gram positive and some Gram negative bacteria. The presence of amino group helps the antibiotic to penetrate the outer membrane of the Gram penative becteria. A projeillin

membrane of the Gram negative bacteria. Ampicillin inhibits the enzyme transpeptidase which is required for cell wall synthesis. It binds to the penicillin binding proteins and acts as an analogue of acyl-D-alanyl-D-alanine, acylating the transpeptidase enzyme. Eventually inhibiting the crosslinking of peptidoglycan of the cell wall, the final stage of cell wall formation, and ultimately resulting in the lysis of

the cell.

Ampicillin is used in cell culture as a selective agent.

A023 is a sterile filtered solution formulated to contain

100mg ampicillin per ml.

Directions:

Recommended use concentration is 100ml/L. Sensitive cell lines may react differently to this product. Hence it is recommended to determine optimum usage dose empirically for individual cell line.
