## Legi Growth Supplement (Twin Pack)

FD016A

A chemical enrichment supplement recommended for enhancing growth of *Legionella* species.

### Composition

Per vial sufficient for 500 ml medium

Ingredients	Concentration
Part A	"
L-Cysteine hydrochloride	200mg
Part B	"
Ferric pyrophosphate, soluble	125mg
Sodium selenite	5mg
Distilled water	5ml

### Directions:

Rehydrate the contents of part A with 5 ml sterile distilled water. Warm up the refrigerated solutions of part B to room temperature. Aseptically add Part A and Part B to 490 ml of sterile, molten, cooled (45-50°C) Legionella Agar Base [M809](#) / Legionella Enrichment Broth Base [M1399](#) along with the Selective Supplements as desired. Mix well and pour into sterile Petri plates.

### Type of specimen

Water samples

### Specimen Collection and Handling

For water samples follow appropriate techniques for handling specimens as per established guidelines (1). After use, contaminated materials must be sterilized by autoclaving before discarding.

Store at 2 - 8°C. Use before expiry date on the label.

Follow established laboratory procedures in disposing of infectious materials and material that comes into contact with clinical sample must be decontaminated and disposed of in accordance with current laboratory techniques (2,3).
