Novobiocin

Directions:

Rehydrate the contents of 1 vial aseptically with 5ml of sterile distilled water. Mix gently to dissolve the contents completely. Aseptically add the rehydrated contents of one vial to 1000ml of sterile, cooled (45-50°C) of Salmonella Selective Enrichment Broth Base M1843 / Salmonella Selective Enrichment Broth Base, Granulated GM1843. Mix well and dispense as desired.
